

> WHITE WITCH COURSE



> The White Witch Golf Course was named by the architects Robert von Hagge and Rick Baril, in honour of Annie Palmer, the 19th century owner of the original plantation on which the course is built. The course has been described as 'alluringly dangerous and unpredictable' by von Hagge. Opened in 2000, the White Witch course was crafted on 600 acres of lush countryside, including mountainous terrain. Golfers are afforded panoramic views of the Caribbean Ocean from 16 holes and are best advised to be on guard as shifting winds.

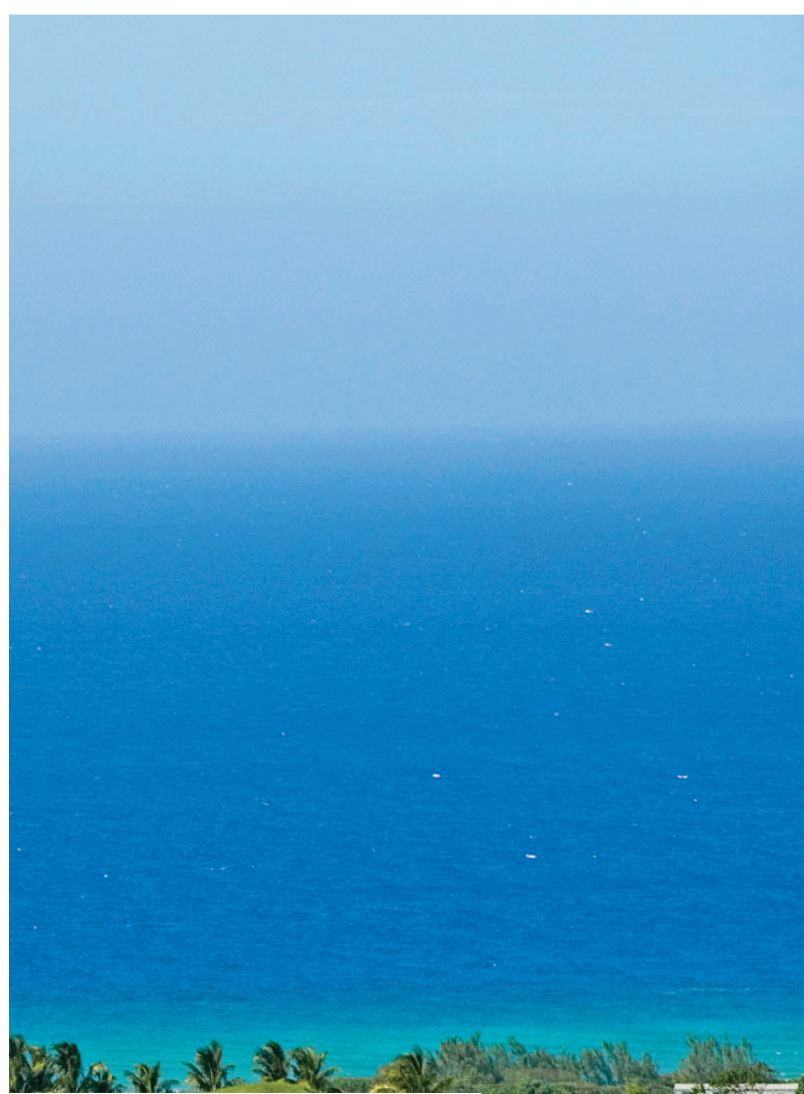
